<b>Distinction Criteria - Practical Driving Assessment</b>	
<b>D1:</b>	<b>Make fewer errors and start to demonstrate advanced and courteous driving skills for example enhanced application of the highway code and defensive and economic driving skills</b>

<b>D2:</b>	<b>Go above and beyond what is expected of their role, for example, demonstration of particularly fast, efficient and new ways of working and improved ways of working</b>

<b>D3:</b>	<b>Demonstrate originality in the consistent, effective application of technical processes, resources, techniques and materials</b>
Evidence from Practical Driving Assessment	
<b>D4:</b>	<b>Complete tasks independently to a level that far exceeds the minimum standard with few or no errors</b>
Evidence from Practical Driving Assessment	
<b>D5:</b>	<b>Select and use appropriate skills and processes, justifying their choices</b>

<b>D6:</b>	<b>Be able to challenge where appropriate and identify solutions rather than just problems or issues</b>
